

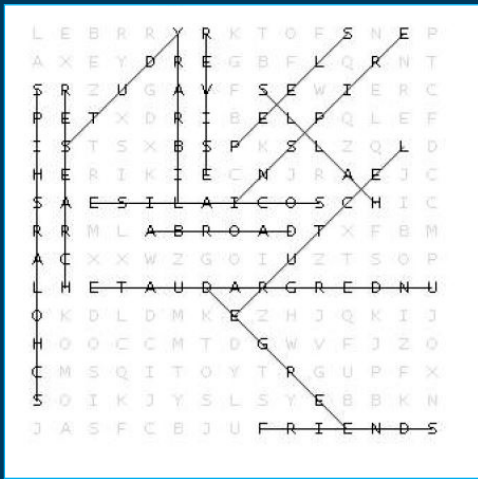
University Definitions
