

St Mary's University Entry Requirements

Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)

International Entry Requirements

Canada

Ontario: An overall average of 85% in 6 Grade 12 University or University/College preparation courses, including a minimum of 85% in Chemistry or Biology. This must include 80% in other subjects including Calculus and English Language

British Columbia: An overall average of 85% in 5 Grade 12 subjects, including a minimum of 85% in Chemistry or Biology. This must include 80% in other subjects including Pre-Calculus or Calculus and English Language or English Studies

Quebec: An overall average of 85% in 5 DEC (Diplôme d'Études Collégiales) subjects, including a minimum of 85% in Chemistry or Biology. This must include 80% in other subjects including Calculus and English Language

Nova Scotia: An overall average of 85% in 5 Grade 12 subjects, including a minimum of 85% in Chemistry or Biology this must include 80% in other subjects including Pre-Calculus or Calculus and English Language.

All other provinces/territories: An overall average of 85% to include 85% in Chemistry or Biology and one other science. This must include 80% in other subjects including Calculus and English Language

Ghana

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to take the International Baccalaureate Diploma, A levels or an International Foundation degree programme.

Students holding a degree-level qualification from Ghana must have achieved a minimum 2:1 honours degree in any discipline awarded within the last two years plus three A Levels at grades ABB, including Chemistry or Biology and another science (to include one of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Maths). One of these must be at grade A or an equivalent international qualification. The minimum GCSE or level 2 qualifications requirements must also be met.

The minimum GCSE or level 2 Mathematics and English qualifications requirements must also be met where the West African Senior School Certificate Examination (WASSCE) is an acceptable equivalent. A grade of B3 is required in Mathematics and English for GCSE grade B/6.

Hong Kong

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to complete the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) with minimum final grades of 5,5,5. Applicants one of the combinations of subjects as listed below:

- Three elective subjects;
- Two elective subjects and English language or Chinese language
- Two elective subjects and Core and Extended Mathematics (M1 or M2)

The minimum GCSE or level 2 Mathematics and English qualifications requirements must also be met where the HKDSE is an acceptable equivalent. A grade of 4 is required in Mathematics (Extended Mathematics or Core Mathematics) and English Language for GCSE grade B/6.

India

The Indian Standard XII will be considered for entry onto the MBBS.

For CBSE/CISCE/West Bengal State exam boards; an overall average grade of 85% to include 85% in two academic non-mathematical subjects, plus a minimum of 80% in English and Mathematics.

For all other state exam boards; an overall average grade of 90% to include 90% in two academic non-mathematical subjects, plus a minimum of 85% in English and 85% in Mathematics.

For applicants applying for degree programmes requiring GCSE grade B/5 in Mathematics we will accept Mathematics from either the Standard X or Standard XII qualification with a minimum of 85%.

Kenya

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to take the International Baccalaureate Diploma, A levels or an International Foundation degree programme.

Students holding a degree-level qualification from Kenya must have achieved a minimum 2:1 honours degree in any discipline awarded within the last two years plus three A Levels at grades ABB, including Chemistry or Biology and another science (to include one of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Maths). One of these must be at grade A or an equivalent international qualification. The minimum GCSE or level 2 qualifications requirements must also be met.

The minimum GCSE or level 2 Mathematics and English qualifications requirements must also be met where the Kenyan Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) is an acceptable equivalent. A grade of B is required in Mathematics and English Language for GCSE grade B/6.

Kuwait

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to take the International Baccalaureate Diploma, A levels or an International Foundation degree programme.

The minimum GCSE or level 2 Mathematics and English qualifications requirements must also be met with a minimum final grade of B/6 in Mathematics and English Language.

Malaysia

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to complete the Senior Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) is acceptable for entry with grades of A2, A2, A2, A2, including Chemistry or Biology and another science.

The minimum GCSE or level 2 Mathematics requirements must also be met where the Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) is an acceptable equivalent. A grade of B is required in Mathematics for GCSE grade B/6.

Nigeria

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to complete the Higher National Diploma with a final grade upper credit.

Students holding a degree-level qualification from Nigeria must have achieved a minimum 2:1 honours degree in any discipline awarded within the last two years plus three A Levels at grades ABB, including Chemistry or Biology and another science (to include one of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Maths). One of these must be at grade A or an equivalent international qualification. The minimum GCSE or level 2 qualifications requirements must also be met.

The minimum GCSE or level 2 Mathematics and English qualifications requirements must also be met where the West African Senior School Certificate Examination (WASSCE) is an acceptable equivalent. A grade of B3 is required in Mathematics and English for GCSE grade B/6.

Pakistan

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to take the International Baccalaureate Diploma, A levels or an International Foundation degree programme.

Applicants who have complete year 1 of a 4-year Bachelor Degree in a subject related to medicine from Pakistan must have achieved a minimum final GPA of 2.8/4 or 70% (Top ranking University) or a minimum final GPA 3.0/4 or 75% (Lower ranking university).

The minimum GCSE or level 2 Mathematics and English qualifications requirements must also be met with a minimum final grade of B/6 in Mathematics and English Language.

Saudi Arabia

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to take the International Baccalaureate Diploma, A levels or an International Foundation degree programme.

The minimum GCSE or level 2 Mathematics and English qualifications requirements must also be met with a minimum final grade of B/6 in Mathematics and English Language.

UAE

UAE Secondary school qualification not accepted. For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to take the International Baccalaureate Diploma, A levels or an International Foundation degree programme.

Applicants holding a degree-level qualification from the UAE must have achieved a minimum 2:1 honours degree in any discipline awarded within the last two years plus three A Levels at grades ABB, including Chemistry or Biology and another science (to include one of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Maths). One of these must be at grade A or an equivalent international qualification. The minimum GCSE or level 2 qualifications requirements must also be met.

USA

For entry onto the MBBS, applicants are required to achieve a GPA of 3.3 or higher in the High School Graduation Diploma, and a minimum 3 AP examinations with grades of 5, 5, 5 or higher. These must include Chemistry or Biology and another science (to include one of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Maths)
