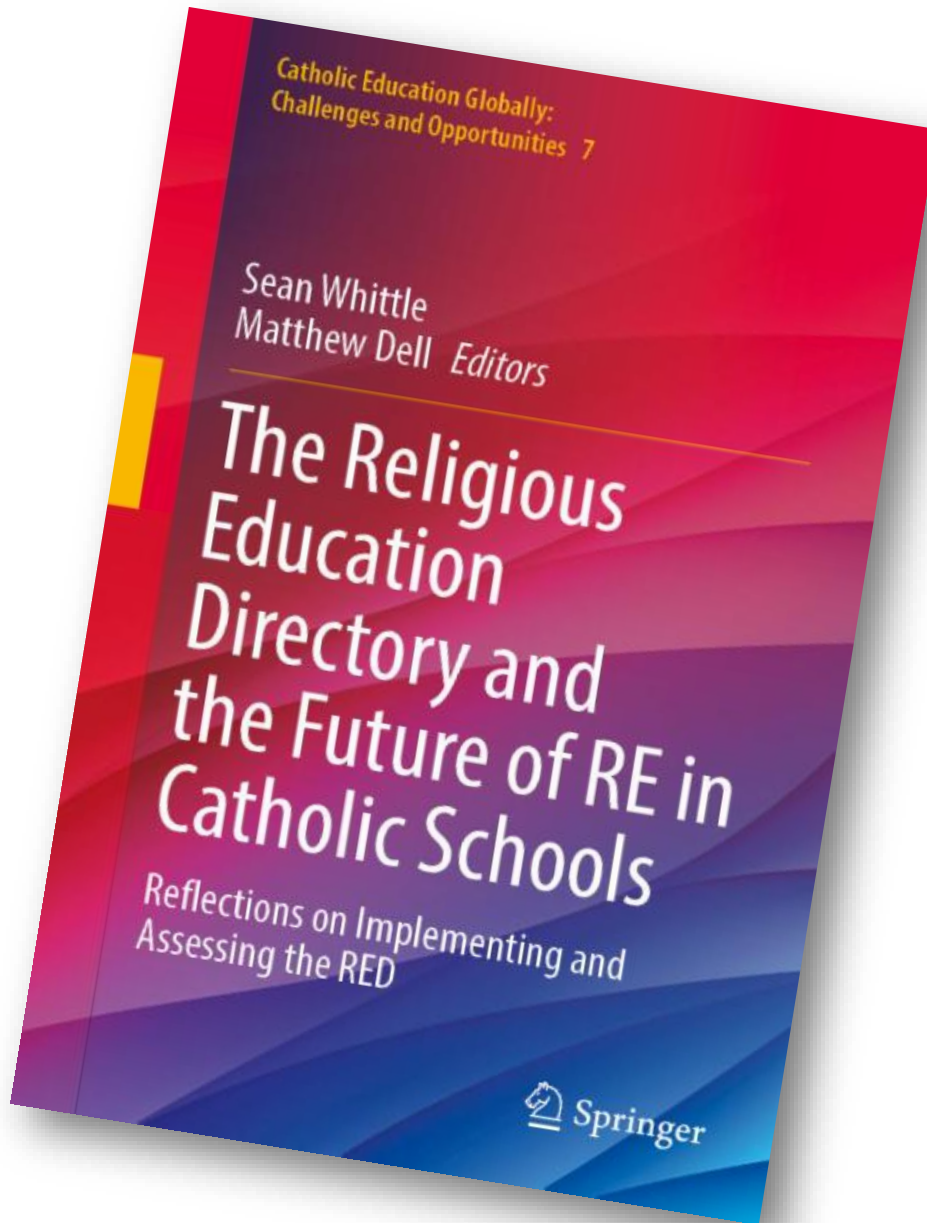


You are warmly welcome to a Book launch!
