International Admissions



Are you CAS Ready?

- **Submit your documents**
 - Email Internationaladmissions@stmarys.ac.uk or upload via the St Mary's Applicant Portal
- **Accept your Offer**
 - Log into the applicant portal → “My Application” → “Respond to offer”
- **Attend your SMU Credibility Interview**
 - Be prepared to discuss Your History, Universities and the UK, Your Course, Finances, Student Visa Responsibilities
- **Complete your deposit payment**
 - £8,000 deposit via applicant portal (Unconditional Offer holders)

How to Request your CAS Statement

Access CAS Shield

- An email from International Admissions titled "Your CAS Request"
- A second email from stmarys@cas-shield.com titled "Welcome to CAS Shield" - Click the invitation link and set your password
- Complete all fields to request your CAS Statement!

Financial Evidence and TB Tests

Only required if UKVI regulations apply based on your country

TB Tests - <https://www.gov.uk/tb-test-visa>

Financial Evidence - <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/financial-evidence-for-student-and-child-student-route-applicants>

- Funds must be held for 28 consecutive days
- Financial evidence must be no more than 31 days old
- Bank Statements/documents must show an additional £500 for currency fluctuations
- Evidence must be in your name, parent's, or legal guardian's name
- All documents must be officially stamped and uploaded as clear copies

Submit your Visa application

- **Confirm your CAS Statement**

Check all details carefully and reply to your Draft CAS Email to receive your Final CAS Statement

- **Submit your Visa application**

Use your CAS Number to apply for your Student Route visa

- **Update CAS Shield**

→ Arrival Date

→ Visa copy (Share code)

- ☒ **Do not book any non-refundable flights:**

Wait to receive a decision on your visa.

- ☒ **Do not enter the UK before your visa start date**

If you enter the UK too soon, you may need to leave again!

Travel and Arrival



Essential Planning

In the weeks before you travel:

- Read our **pre-departure advice** at <https://www.stmarys.ac.uk/international/prepare/get-ready.aspx>
- Plan how to access **money** until you can open a bank account. Have a credit card and/or a prepaid debit card for emergencies (Visa or Mastercard).
- Fill any necessary **prescriptions** and take care of **healthcare** appointments
- Confirm your **accommodation** and plan how to get there when you arrive (contact international@stmarys.ac.uk if you need support)
- Follow your travel provider's **coronavirus testing** protocols, if they have any. There are currently no coronavirus entry requirements in England

Booking travel

Before you buy a ticket:

1. Have your visa, if necessary. Make sure to arrive after your entry clearance starts.
2. Have a confirmed place to live
3. Check your start date:

Entering the UK

- E-mail international@stmarys.ac.uk if you need advice about travel arrangements
- Carry paper copies of your **St Mary's offer letter, proof of finances and accommodation** in your hand luggage
- See a Border Force Officer to **check if you need a passport stamp** and **keep your boarding pass** to show when you arrived
- **Your ID check:** The St Mary's University visa team must meet with you face-to-face during the enrolment period for your ID check. You must present yourself with your passport and your share code.

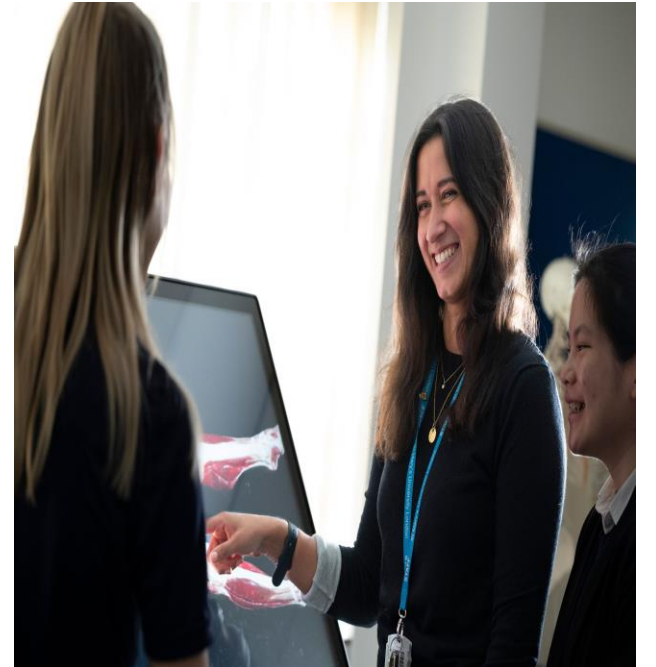
After you arrive

You can do some things only after you're here:

- Please download **MySMU app**: required for attendance, time-table and regular updates.
- **Open a bank account**: After you enrol online, you can request a banking letter through your e:Vision student portal. See <https://www.stmarys.ac.uk/international/student-life/%E2%80%8Bopening-a-bank-account.aspx> for details.
- **Register with a GP (doctor)**: This will also give you access to the COVID vaccination programme. For details, see www.stmarys.ac.uk/international/student-life/%E2%80%8Baccessing-health-services.aspx
- **Get a National Insurance Number** (if you have permission to work): You need to apply for this before you start work. Full instructions here: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-national-insurance-number>
