

Coronavirus: Continuing to study whilst in self-isolation

Guidance for Postgraduate Research Students Updated 13 March 2020

Whilst self-isolating you may feel well enough to engage with your studies. If this is the case, follow the guidance below:

- 1. Please ensure you have informed Student Services:
 - Completing the online referral form <u>Student Self-notification Form</u>
 - Telephone 020 8240 8238 or 020 8240 2359 (Mon-Fri 9am -5pm),
 - Outside office hours you can telephone Security 020 8240 4335
- 2. Inform your Primary Research Supervisor and research@stmarys.ac.uk as quickly as possible.
- 3. Avoid contact with other students and staff.
- 4. **Contact your Primary Research Supervisor** on a regular basis (once a week) to seek any guidance on how to access supervision support or guidance.
