

CV Checks with Career Set



St Mary's students and graduates now have access to our new CV Checking and Feedback system (<u>CareerSet</u>).

Upload your CV in PDF format to get AI analysis on multiple factors including action words, segments, brevity and content. It will then generate a score. You can click through each section to get detailed suggestions, adjust and make changes and re-run the submission to see the improvement.

Students can login to <u>CareerSet</u> using their St Mary's email address. You can still use it once you have graduated!
