The BUCS 2023/24 season has concluded with impressive results.

Men's lacrosse achieved a 100% win rate, including the cup final. Women's futsal followed with 82%, and men's futsal 2nd team secured 78%, with men's tennis close behind at 77%.


Overall, lacrosse led with a 71% club win rate, women's rugby union at 67%, and men's football and futsal at 49%. We won 41% of fixtures this season.
