Under this month's spot light Student Engagement- one of our key services that provides you with support!

The Student Engagement team supports students from traditionally less represented or advantaged backgrounds, to ensure all students can thrive at University.

Look out for our initiatives, such as Get Set for Success, Wobble Week, Commuter Mentoring, EDI training, Student Callouts, Mental Health events, Digital Equality Scheme, and Student Engagement Awards.

The **Student Engagement Fund**, enables students facing financial barriers to engage fully with SMU life, by subsidising the costs of extracurricular or course-related activities. The fund awards up to £175 each time and has supported many Simmies with the costs of: sports and society membership, DBS checks, BSL interpreters, visiting speakers, course kit, course trips, graduation, and more.

Become a Student Senior Resident




